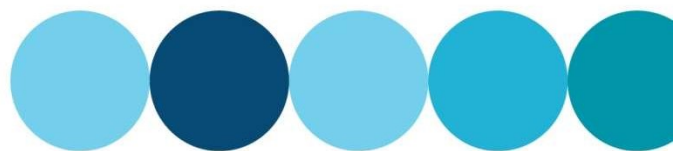


# Project update

## Manning Wastewater Upgrades



### What is happening?

As you may be aware, we are currently upgrading the wastewater pump station located on Jarman Avenue, in Manning. This work will help improve the safe disposal of wastewater in the City of South Perth, and support the continued growth of the community.

Due to a change in design standards, we have modified the design of the new wastewater pump station to accommodate a new power supply. This has caused a delay to the project timeline and changed the way the upgrades will be completed.

### What has changed?

To minimise community impact, the upgrades will now be completed in two phases.

#### Phase one

Our authorised contractor, DM Civil, will connect the new underground pump station to the existing wastewater infrastructure and make it operational. They will also decommission and remove the existing pump station and complete minor modifications to the emergency overflow basin. Before leaving site, the underground pump station will be made operational, the site office will be removed, and mulch will be installed as a temporary reinstatement. This phase of work is currently in progress and is expected to be completed by early September.

#### Phase two

Phase two includes the installation of a new power supply, which will be completed by a third-party provider. Following this work, DM Civil will return to site to upgrade the pumps in the underground pump station, connect the pump station to the new power supply, and complete the final reinstatements to the area.

The timing of this work depends on a third-party provider. We will provide an update when details have been confirmed.

### How will this impact me?

During construction, you may notice an increase in activity, truck movements and noise. A temporary increase in odour may be experienced when we remove the existing aboveground pump station.

Please be assured that the final reinstatement of the affected areas will take place upon completion of phase two. While most of the new pump station will be operational underground, there will be large electrical cabinets visible aboveground.

We are working with the City of South Perth to restore the vegetation impacted by our work and ways we can make the aboveground electrical infrastructure more visibly pleasing to the community.
